3	B	Student consistently demonstrates <b>understanding</b> of <b>core concepts</b> and the ability to apply academic knowledge and skills drawn from course standards in <b>familiar contexts</b> .	75%
2.5	B/C		62.5%
2	C	Student demonstrates <b>no major errors regarding the fundamental concepts, skills, and processes</b> . This level serves as the foundation for attaining higher level learning.	50%
