

**Dear Summer School Families:** 

Please remember that Waubesa Intermediate School classrooms are NUT FREE. While students may bring snacks to enjoy between classes, only NUT FREE foods will be allowed in classrooms. These restrictions do not apply to the lunchroom or outdoor setting.

## **HEALTH SERVICES RESPONSIBILITY:**

- WIS Health Office will be staffed during Summer School office hours 7:45-11:45 am.
- Teachers will be informed of students with significant health conditions, emergency medications and • be provided necessary training or instructions according to the student's health plan(s).

If your child has a health concern and/or medication and is registered for summer school, please continue reading and note the following guidelines:

## PARENT RESPONSIBILITY:

- Please notify the health office of any changes to your child's medical conditions.
- Deliver all *Emergency Medication* (Epi-pens, Glucagon, Seizure Rescue Medication, Inhalers) to WIS Health Office before your child's summer session begins. Please check the expiration date on these medications. A Medication Consent Form is required if not already on file from 2024-25 school vear.
- If you prefer your student to self-carry emergency medication (Epi-Pen, Inhaler) please place medication in your child's backpack and inform the teacher & health office on the first day of each session of its location. A Medication Consent Form is required if not already on file from 2024-25 school year.
- Please contact Sadie Frank, WIS Health Assistant (608)838-4673, FrankS@mcfsd.org to arrange for • storage and delivery of any *daily or as needed medications* your child may need to take during summer school hours. A Medication Consent Form is required if not already on file from 2024-25 school year. Some as needed medication (Tylenol, Ibuprofen, Tums, Cough Drops) are available in the Health Office with prior parent consent provided during 2024-25 online enrollment.
