VISION CARE RESOURCES

BadgerCare

- If your child is on BadgerCare they can receive an eye exam and glasses annually. Please call the number on the back of your child's health care card to find a vision care provider or you can look up your child's HMO contact number in the link here. Contact member services by phone at 800-362-3002.

Lions Club

Eyecare America

Vision USA
