# Madison Bike Tour

Please read and returned signed **NO LATER THAN TUESDAY, MAY 8!**

**Keep in mind that the choice for this trip was made in February and no switching is allowed.**

## Eligibility Requirements:

The unit six, seven, and eight staff members view this trip as a privilege, and the eligibility guidelines are consistent with the other end-of-the-quarter Celebration Day activities. **The cut-off date for determining eligibility for the trip is Friday, June 1.** Students will be eligible to attend a trip if, by the **June 1, 2018** deadline, they have:

- Passed all of their classes for the fourth quarter (No F's).
- Earned Conduct and Effort Grades for the fourth quarter above a "U" for Unsatisfactory.
- Earned a cumulative grade point average above a 1.7.
- Returned any library and classroom books and **paid any fees.**

**There are no exceptions to the above requirements:** As a staff, we will regularly inform students of their academic progress and eligibility status. Please discuss these requirements with your child and help them to qualify for this fun and exciting trip. If your child does not meet the eligibility requirements, he/she will be expected to attend school on this day. The cost of the trip will be refunded.

## **Madison Bike Tour Information:**

The group will leave on bikes from IMMS at approximately 8:45 AM and will **return to IMMS around 3:00 PM.** Students should bring a bag lunch, backpack, sunscreen, a towel, and swimsuit (if desired), in addition to a workable bicycle and a bike helmet. Students who go on this trip will take a scenic bike ride from IMMS to Madison along the new bike path to Lake Farm Park, eventually stopping at Brittingham Park (Brittingham Boats) to enjoy kayaking, fishing, and other water sports on Madison's lakes! The trip fee of \$15.00 includes payment for activities at the Brittingham boathouse (including: the cost of an hour rental of paddle boat, canoe, kayak, or stand up paddle board), a single scoop of ice-cream in a cone or dish at Chocolate Shoppe, and a snack at the boathouse. We will bike in the rain, unless there is a threat for severe weather [including thunderstorms].

**Please Note:** All students are required to stay with the bike tour group at all times. When using the Brittingham Boats' equipment, students must stay in Monona Bay and cannot cross under the railroad bridges to enter Lake Monona. ***Students who choose not to follow these rules will have a parent contacted to come and pick them up from the biking tour.***
