

## HERE COMES SUMMER SCHOOL!!

It's time to start making plans for another very exciting summer school program in the McFarland School District. This year we will feature several new classes along with many time-honored favorites.

**Information:** Complete information concerning summer school will be available online sometime in March. This is your opportunity to pre-register student information, get acquainted with the system, and review the timetable for all classes. **On-Line Registration:** One big improvement this year is that registration for remedial classes will also be online. Registration for enrichment classes, **as well as all K-8 Academies and Extended Learning classes**, will open at 7:00 P.M. on Monday, April 12<sup>th</sup>. Go to the school website at <http://www.mcfarland.k12.wi.us> and click on the link to online registration. Since Academies and Extended Learning classes require teacher recommendation, access to these classes will be restricted to those parents whose children have been referred. A password will be necessary to allow registration in remedial classes, and this password will be provided to those parents in the student referral letter.

**Location:** In most cases, classes for grades Pre-K to 5 will be at Conrad Elvehjem and McFarland Primary Schools, while classes for older students will be at the high school.

**Enrichment Classes:** Our enrichment classes will run during three 2-week sessions. We're offering many new classes this summer such as Card Creations, Into the Garden, Wild Weather, Super Sleuths, and yoga classes for all grade levels. All classes, except Babysitting and Bicycling Wisconsin, will run Monday through Thursday (except the week of July 5).

**Remedial Classes:** Our remedial classes will again be split into two separate sessions. The Academy classes, for the students who demonstrate the greatest academic need, will run for 4 weeks. The Extended Learning classes, for students who would still benefit from some assistance, will run for 2 weeks for grades 3-8 and 3 weeks for grades K-2. All classes will run Monday through Thursday (except the week of July 5).
