

Important Reminders About COVID-19:



- 1. Please carefully note the signs and symptoms of COVID-19 on the attached checklist prior to any in-person school sessions.**
- 2. Please notify the front office at the school building your student attends if you are keeping your student home related to COVID-19. They will notify the health office and your student's classroom teacher.**
- 3. Please send all sick calls (even non-COVID related) through your school's attendance line/front office. They will notify the health office and your student's classroom teacher.**
- 4. Please provide a note from your provider to the health office if your student is evaluated for COVID-19. This maybe be an electronically signed note from MyChart.**

- 6. Please do not send students to school if they are ill at all, but especially with COVID-19 symptoms as described in the checklist attached.**
- 7. Students should still remain home for a fever 100°F or greater, vomiting, or diarrhea even when COVID-19 is ruled out. These are contagious symptoms that exclude a student from school even if they do not have COVID-19.**

COVID –19 Symptom Screening Checklist



(Please check your students against this list prior to each day of in-person school attendance.)

If your student has one of the following three symptoms they must be evaluated by a healthcare provider for COVID-19, and may not attend school until that evaluation is turned into the health office:

Cough (new and/or persistent and not getting better)

Short of breath, or having trouble breathing

New loss of taste or smell

If your student has two of the following symptoms they must be evaluated by a healthcare provider for COVID-19, and may not attend school until that evaluation is turned into the health office:

Congestion/runny nose

Fever (100°F or greater) or (persistent) chills

Nausea/vomiting/stomachache

Diarrhea

Headache

Fatigue

Muscle or Body aches

Sore Throat

Please Note:

“Evaluated by a healthcare provider” includes:

- Virtual visit
- Telephone triage with decision
- In-person appointment

***If your child needs to be evaluated by a healthcare provider, we need documentation from that provider indicating that COVID-19 testing is not indicated, or with the date the student may return.**

***If someone in your household is being evaluated for COVID-19, all students in the household should remain home until the evaluation is complete and/or test results are received.**
