The McFarland orchestra department is pleased to offer *summer orchestra* for beginning students. Please note that grade levels refer to **grade students will be in the fall**. Please complete the online form, <https://tinyurl.com/SummerOrchestraGrade5> or return a printed form to Mrs. Hershey (or school mailbox at WIS, IMMS, or MHS) by *July 19*. Registrations will be accepted until Wednesday, August 8.

Summer orchestra will get students started and on the right path for the fall. 5th grade students are not expected to take summer private lessons. If your child will not be able to take the two weeks of summer orchestra, summer lessons would be a great option. If your child will only be available for one week of summer orchestra, that is fine. Please indicate that on the sign up form.

Students will need an instrument and “Essential Elements Book 1” for summer orchestra. It is best if they also have a folding music stand or a piano at home in which to place their music when they practice. Ward-brodt will bring your rented instruments to school the week before summer orchestra so they will be tuned and ready to play on August 6, the first day of class.

Mrs. Hershey, along with high school student helpers will be on site for summer orchestra to teach your child. Please contact Mrs. Hershey with other questions you may have.

Summer Private Lessons

Fifth grade students may take private lessons from an **adult or a high school student** over the summer but are not expected to. Most lessons are scheduled for 30 minutes. Most adults teach in their homes in McFarland or surrounding communities. The High School students will be available to teach at their home or possibly yours. Even if you are only able to take “three lessons” over the summer it is beneficial to sign up. Most teachers’ schedules are a little more flexible for absences in the summer, so ask about what is possible regarding lesson availability and payment options. When contacting any of the teachers for lessons, please leave a message as most teachers do not answer their phone while they are teaching. Please put “Private lesson information” in the subject box if you send an email.

Lessons given by high school students are \$5 -10 per half hour lesson. Lessons given by adults are according to their own fee schedule. Please contact them directly.
