- What has the last four years taught me?
- What challenges in life have I overcome?
- Describe at least one experience that has shaped your life as a young adult. This may include a hobby, extra curricular activity, job experience, or other personal experience.
- Based on your overall high school experience, explain how you have grown as a person. (Think academically, socially, creatively, and emotionally.)

POST-SECONDARY STATEMENT

Describe your future plans and why you have chosen this plan. Include how your high school experience is related to your future plans.



Each individual reflection & your post-secondary statement must be at least 2 paragraphs in length. Please write the reflection & post-secondary statement on the same Google document.

GOOGLESLIDE

Create a Google slide that shows off who you are. You will be presenting this slide to your interviewers at your Exit Interview.

- Ideas of what to include on Google slide:
 - Photos of self, family, friends, pets, places that are important to you
 - Post-secondary plans (college, employment, military, future occupation, etc.)
 - Link to music, dance, sports etc. performance
 - Awards, achievements, honors, certifications
 - Out of school accomplishments (apprenticeships, jobs, 4-H, Scouts, church, hobbies, etc.)
 - Co-Curriculars

This is about YOU! Include what is important to you and what you are comfortable discussing with your interviewers. You can do more than one slide if you prefer.
